Session Descriptions, Registration and Sleeping Rooms:

Use of Force: What Every Court Officer Needs to Know

Few topics in law enforcement garner more attention than use of force. What once wouldn't make the local news now gets national attention. Court Officers must be prepared to meet the challenges of today's ever-changing environment. This course is designed to help court officers make objectively reasonable decisions in accordance with Constitutional Law. This course examines current use of force trends, legal standards, training paradigms, and post-force procedures to enhance officer use of force decision making.

Decision Making Under Stress: How Human Performance Factors Affect Decisions

Human performance factors affect every aspect of decision making under stress. This course examines human performance factors such as System 1 vs. System 2 processing, recognition primed decision making, and reaction times under stress.
